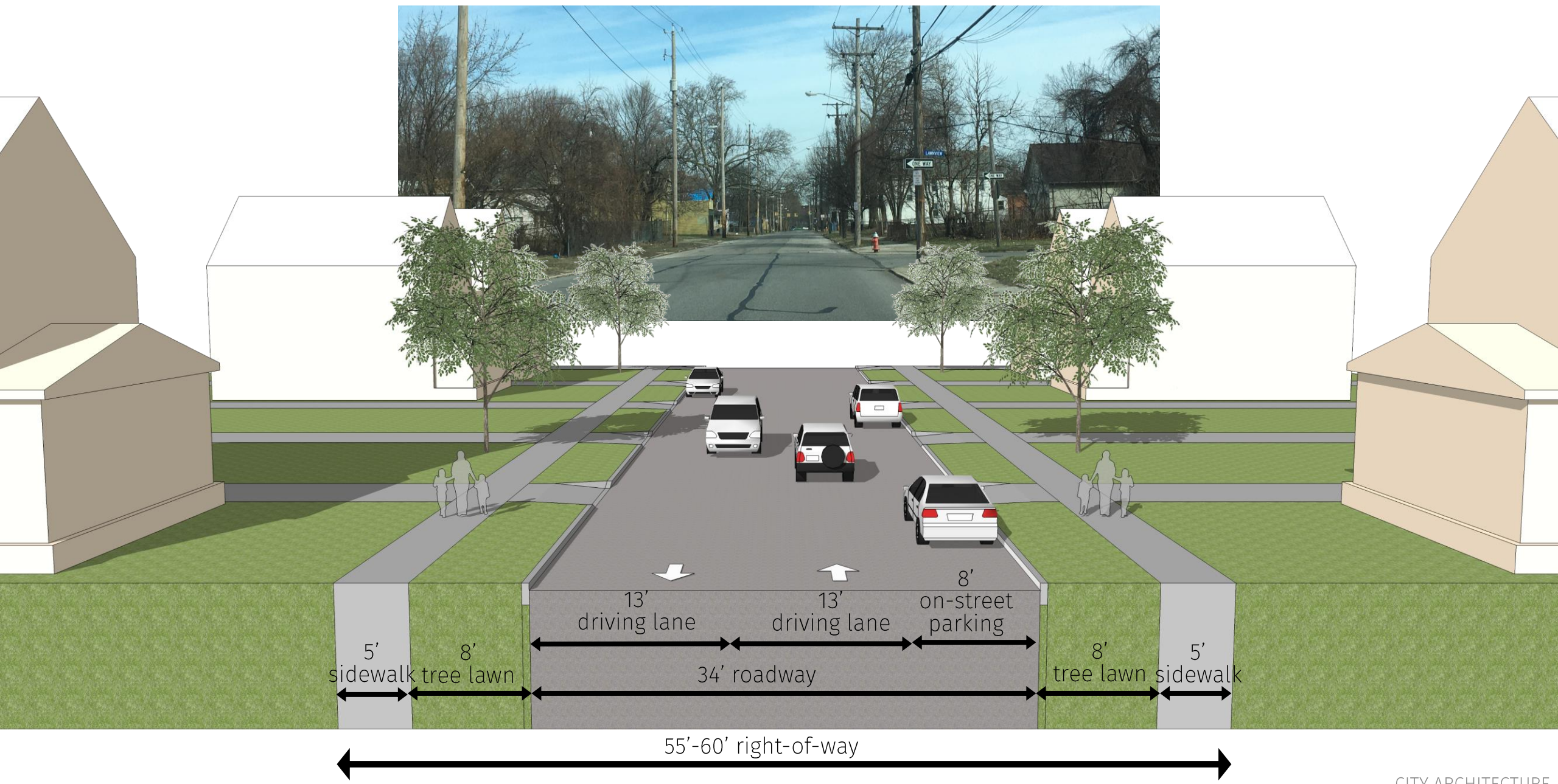

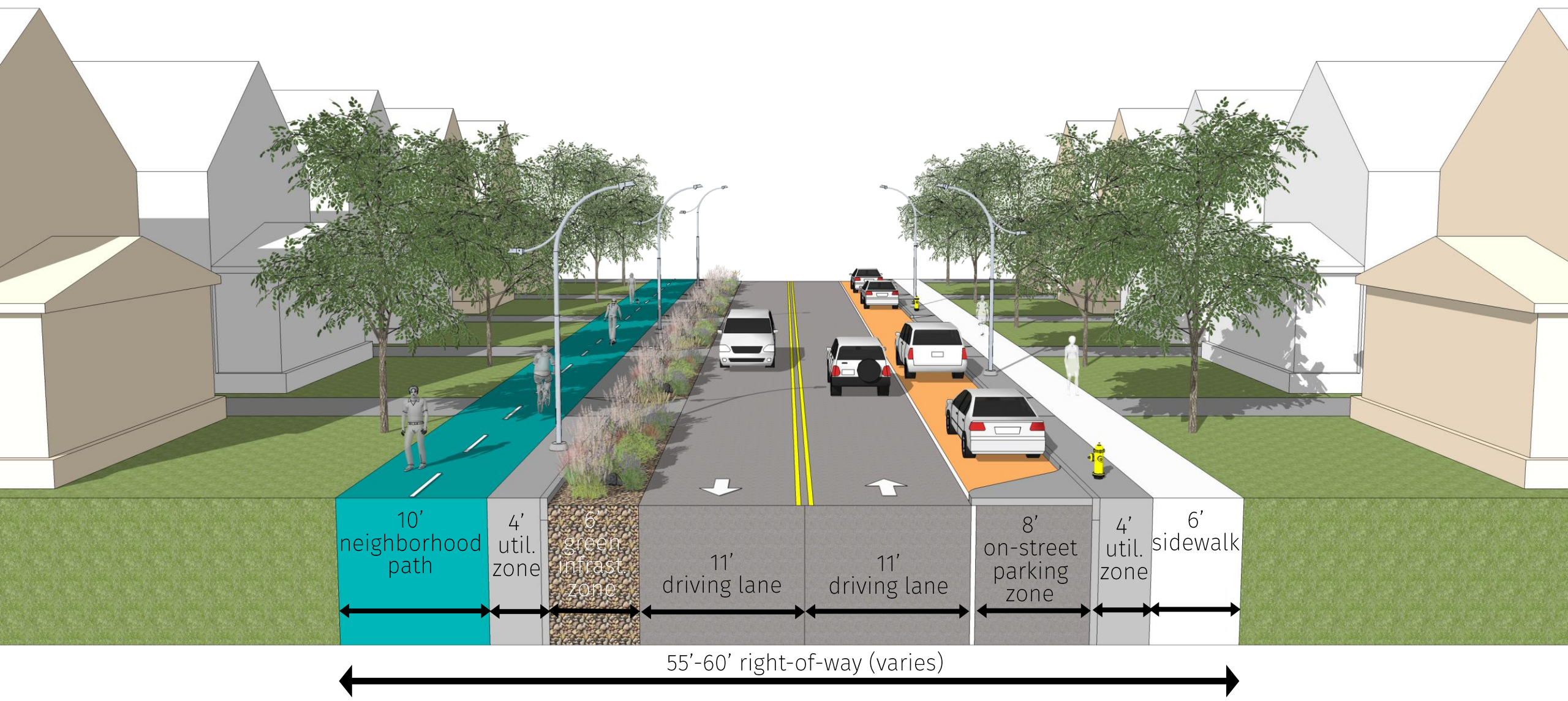

# EAST 66<sup>TH</sup> STREET ROADWAY CONCEPT 6



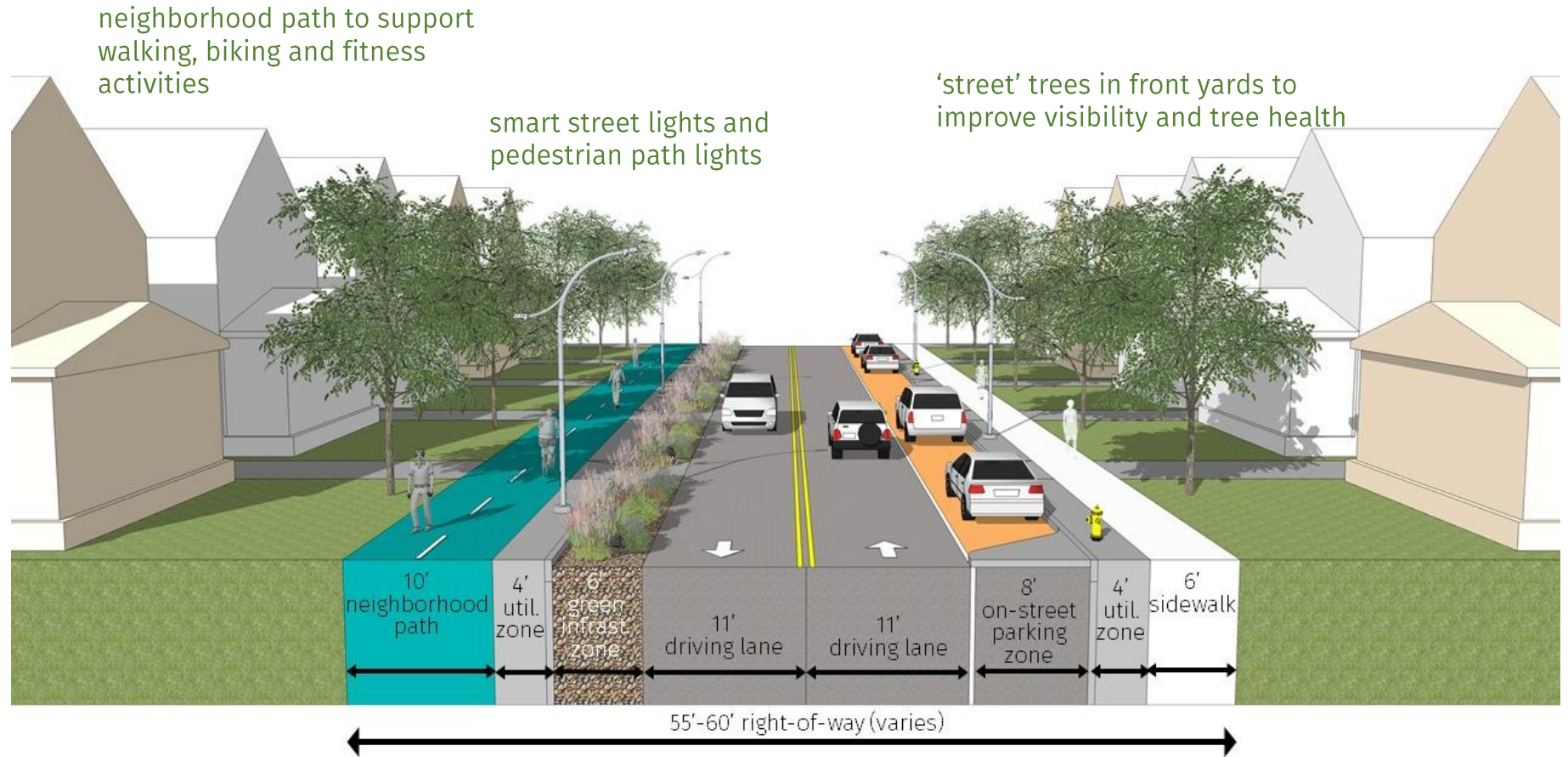


# YOU SAID

“We need a bike lane and places to park our bikes.”

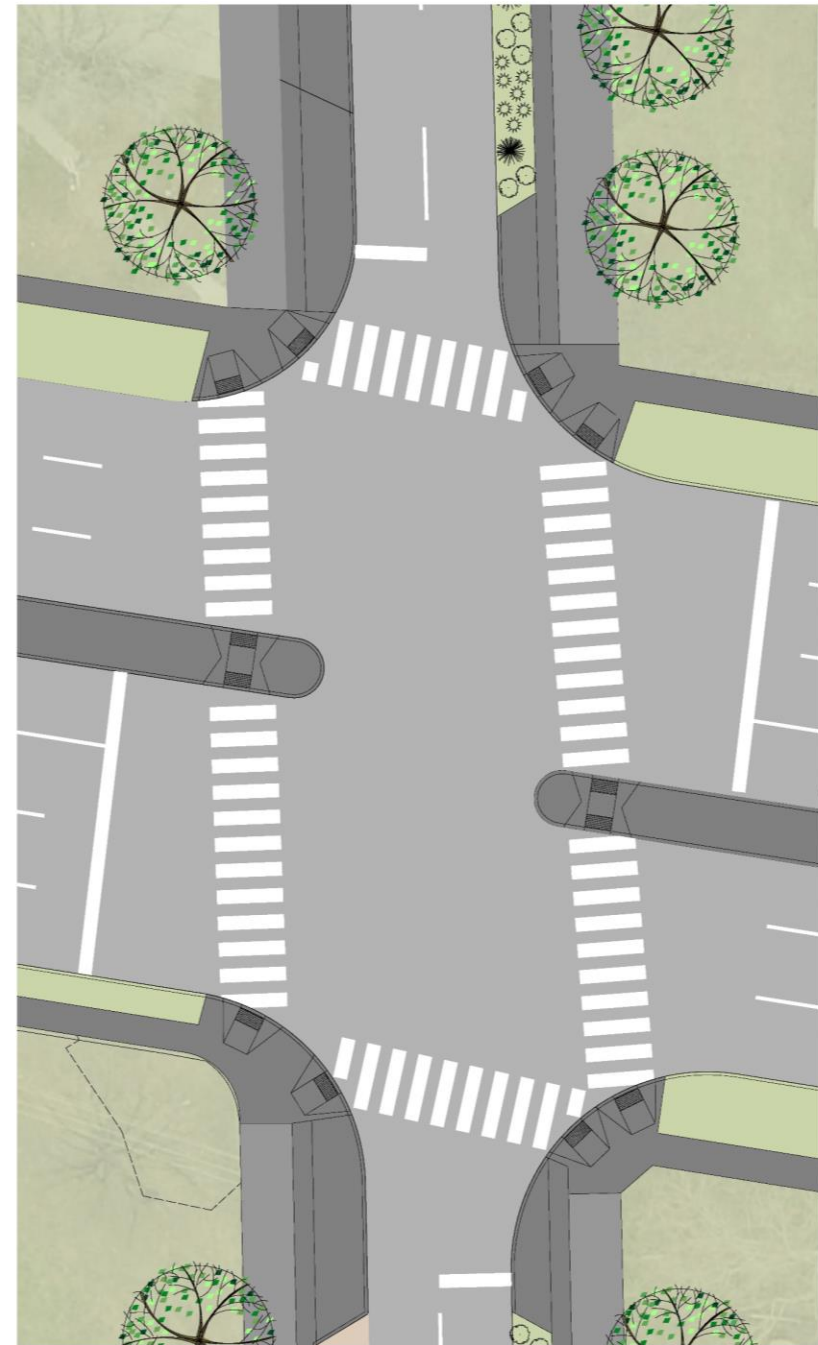


# YOU SAID

Narrowed turning lanes to widen median as pedestrian refuge space

Medians extended into intersection to receive crosswalks

15'-20' wide crosswalks to emphasize pedestrian and bicycle paths of movement

Pedestrian activated crosswalk signals, with audible and visual signals

# YOU SAID

“Affirmations. Yeah. And a lot of colors.”

“The street should be a safe zone similar to the “Safe Zone Sundays” idea at Kerusch Park.”

“To make it safer if we build Hough the same way they got E. 4th where they got all them bars at so you can't even drive a car through there - you know what I mean?”

PLAN**



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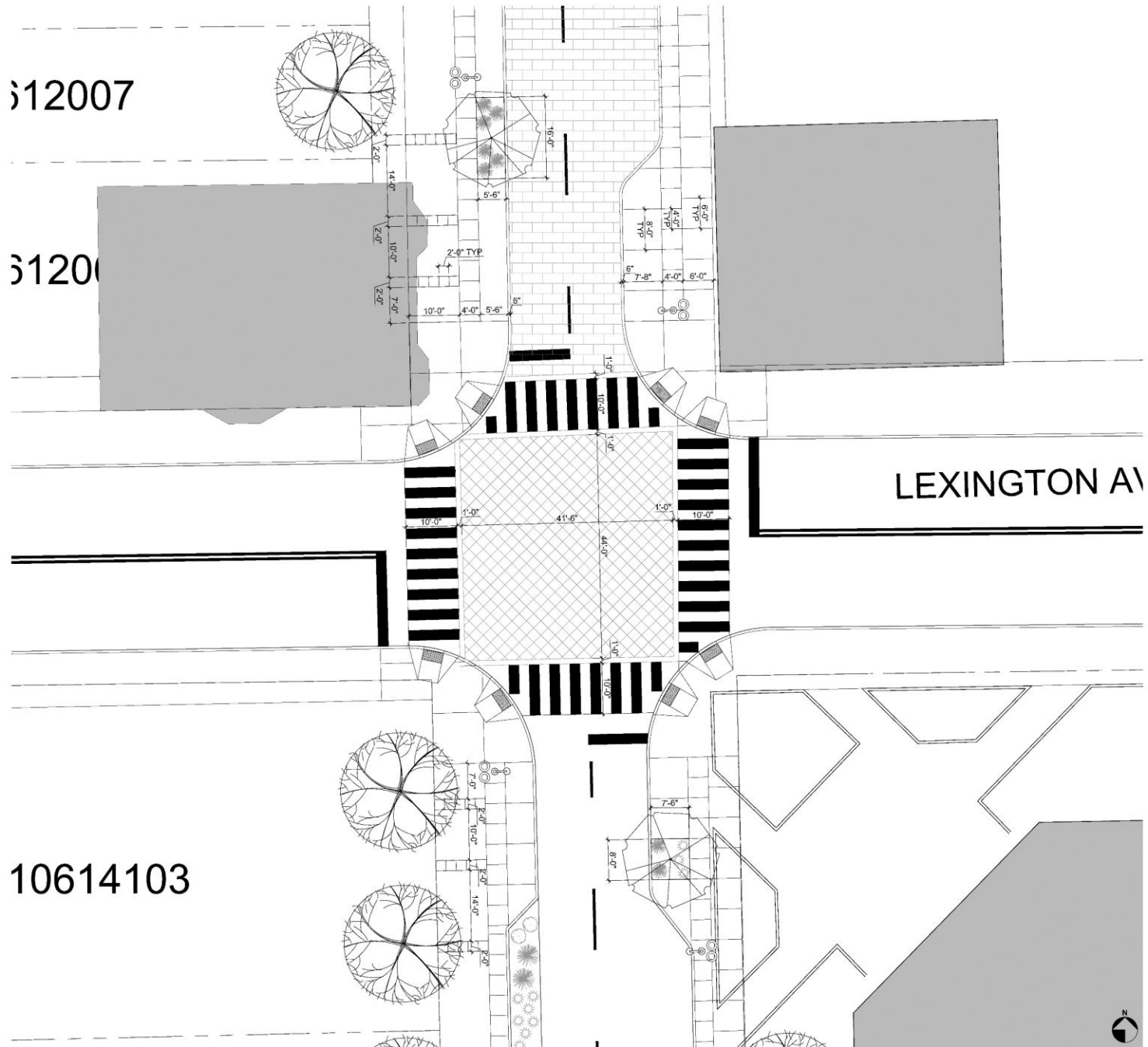
